Dear parents and carers,

It is great to see more of our Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 children returning and it is fantastic to feel the 'BUZZ' of a busy Bubble group. Thank you for choosing to send your children back to school. We feel that it is really important for your child to have the routine of school, see their friends and continue with their school-based learning.

We are expecting confirmation from the government in the next couple of days that we are able to open school more widely to include our pupils in Year 2, Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5 if our risk assessment says it is safe to do so. Having reviewed our 'Covid Secure' arrangements and our risk assessment, we are delighted to tell you that **we are able to open the school to more pupils.**

Your child **may** be able to return on **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June** in a smaller Bubble group. Depending on the number of pupils looking to return, this group may not be with their usual teacher or class, but they will be with children of a similar age. This will give them the opportunity to get used to coming back to school, see some of their friends and have their learning supported by a teacher.

To enable us to plan for more children returning, and so we can make sure Carville is as safe as it can be for children and staff, **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June will be the last chance** for your child to come to school this academic year. The choice we ask you to make now is either:

1. Send your child to school from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2020 until Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020.
- or
2. Your child will return on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2020 at the start of the new school year.

Please note, saying you would like your child to return is not a guarantee of a place. This will depend on the numbers of children wishing to return and a review of our risk assessment. You will be contacted from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June if we have a place for your child.

While your child is not attending school, Seesaw will continue so we can share learning activities and resources, capture your child's learning, and communicate about their progress and needs. **New learning activities will be added for your child every day up until the end of term, Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July.**



We will also provide two learning packs which you can collect from school. These packs have a range of printed learning activities to help you to support your child in revising their literacy, mathematics and other subject knowledge and skills. The first pack is available at the main office now. The second pack will be available to collect from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July.
