Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- To be confident to talk to other children when playing.
- Circle time-explore and talk about feelings and emotions.
- Preparing for Reception.



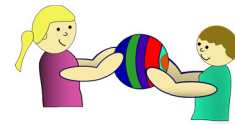
Communication and Language

- To question why things happen and give explanations- what we take on holiday understanding use of objects.
- Talking about our favourite activities in Nursery.



Physical Development

- To eat a healthy range of foodstuffs-Cooking activities.
- Sports Day practise-team work/turn-taking.
- To show increasing control in throwing and catching.



Literacy

- Linking sounds to letters-naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet.
- Segmenting sounds in simple words.
- Sight vocabulary relating to Holidays and Transport.
- Strengthen pencil grip and control for writing-name practise.



Mathematics

- Exploring Capacity in the sand and water tray.
- Begin to combine sets of objects and find the total by counting them all.
- Practise counting beyond 10.
- Count and recognise numerals to 10.



Creative Development

- Capturing experiences and responses with a range of media- Arts Week ‘Ten Pieces’ music and Art activities.
- Exploring pattern and colour.
- Explore different textures and materials-sand pictures-fabric painting etc.



Understanding of the World

- Investigating different materials-what is best for different holidays-cold/hot etc.
- Gardening-understanding growth and change over time.
- Floating and Sinking experiments-talk about why things happen.
